

Are You Covered by Medicaid?

What you need to know about renewing your health coverage.

Every year, the State reviews Medicaid members' information to make sure they are still eligible. If we have enough information, we will send you a notice (Benefit Decision Notice) telling you that we have renewed your Medicaid.

If we need more information, **we will send you two notices:**

- 1 A yellow Medicaid renewal notice.
- 2 A white notice asking for additional documents.

These two notices will arrive in the mail separately. Make sure you watch for both.

3 things you can do to be ready and stay covered.

1. **Keep your account information up to date** so the State can reach you with important information. For example, you should update your account if your contact information changes, you get a new job, or you have a baby.
2. **Watch for mail from the State of Rhode Island.** If the Medicaid program needs more information to renew your coverage, you'll get a yellow notice. You will also get a white notice asking for additional documents. Otherwise, you will get a notice that says your coverage has continued automatically.
3. **Take action right away.** If you get a yellow notice, it means the State needs more information about you or people in your household to renew your coverage. Please submit all requested information by the deadline on your notice.
